**Master of Science Degree**

The Department of Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science (KRS) in the College of Education offers a Master of Science (MS) degree program with three areas of specialization: Athletic Training, Physical Education, and Rehabilitation Counseling. Both Athletic Training and Physical Education consist of two tracks, entry level and advanced certification in Athletic Training and Physical Education and Adapted Physical Education, respectively. The MS degree program provides opportunities for students who wish to pursue advance knowledge and research in one of the above mentioned areas.

Students interested in the MS specialization in physical education or adapted physical education must meet the admission requirements of the Graduate Division and KRS. Both programs assist in the development of the knowledge and skills related to achievement of outcomes necessary for national certification (i.e., national board certification in teaching or nationally certified adapted physical educator). The program is comprised of between 30-33 credits and typically takes two years to complete. A thesis or project option is provided for the research component.

Enrolled students in the MS program will develop basic competence in reading and conducting research, expand comprehensive knowledge relative to content and pedagogy in physical education or adapted physical education, National and state standards, diversity issues, assessment, curriculum, leadership, and advocacy.
